Her Christian faith, walk and experience were evidenced by her serving as pastor residing at Exodus Ministries in Mahanoy City, PA; her founding of an organization called Daughters of Wisdom where she ministered and counseled women in their walk with Christ; and her affiliation with In The Light Ministries, Harrisburg, PA.
