Educated in the Harrisburg School District, Sheila graduated from John Harris High School, Class of 1969. She attended Harrisburg Area Community College studying Criminal Justice and retired from the Pennsylvania Department of Welfare.

As a member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, Sheila served with the Macedonia Mass Choir Ministry under the direction of the late Oscar Porter, Minister of Music, and Donna Porter, Choir Director. Sheila also served as the First Secretary of the Harrisburg Chapter of the Gospel Music Workshop of America.
