



## Silvia Renee Ware Thompson

December 3, 1965 - April 16, 2025

Silvia Renee Ware-Thompson, daughter of the late Leslie A. Ware Sr. and the late Ernestine Shepherd- Ware, was born Friday, December 3, 1965, in Charleston, South Carolina, the sixth of seven children.

Educated in the Harrisburg School District, Silvia attended Lincoln Elementary School, Woodward Elementary School and graduated from William Penn High School, Class of 1984. After her high school graduation, Silvia enlisted in the United States Air Force and then the Air National Guard. Thereafter, she attended Empire Beauty School for Cosmetology advancing from student to teacher.

Silvia's employment path included the United States Postal Service, the New Cumberland Army Depot and the Mechanicsburg Naval Supply Depot totaling nineteen years of federal service.

After meeting the love-of-her-life in the person of Mark A. Thompson Sr., Silvia and Mark were married on April 18, 1987. Their love story was blessed with the birth of two sons, Mark Jr. and Ryan Rashad. Their marriage was EPIC with a thirty-eight-year span. Unfortunately, Silvia did not live to celebrate this milestone.

Leisurely, Silvia stayed in contact with family and friends via her phone and
