Stanley Leon Fears was born on February 6, 1963, in Atlanta, GA. He graduated from high school in Atlanta, GA and later studied Electrical Engineering in college.

He proudly served in the United States Army from 1981 to 1986 as a Cannon Crewman. While stationed in Korea, he earned the Army's Achievement Medal and the Overseas Service Medal. Stanley was employed as a civilian with the Department of Defense and dedicated 25 years to DLA Distribution Susquehanna in Mechanicsburg, PA.

Stanley was a devoted member of the Hebrew Israelite Community for many years. He had a deep love of music and was a talented drummer, DJ, unicyclist and enjoyed boxing.

On Wednesday, June 25, 2025, at the age of sixty-two, Stanley Leon Fears departed this life.
