



Mr. Terry Lee Flood "Joe Louis"

January 26, 1959 - December 7, 2018

Terry Lee Flood, affectionately and better known as "Joe Louis," entered into rest on Friday, December 7, 2018. He was born Monday, January 26, 1959, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, son of the late Lola M. Flood and the late Bolly Venable.

In 1977, Joe graduated from William Penn High School, Harrisburg, PA, and on March 1, 1978, he enlisted into the United States Marine Corps. His military occupational specialties were Infantryman, Machine Gunner, Mortar Man and Anti-Tank Assault Man. While serving his country, Joe was wounded and received an honorable discharge.

His spiritual roots began at the Broad Street Church of God in Christ, later renamed Mount Calvary Church of God in Christ which remained Joe's home church. He truly loved Mount Calvary Church of God in Christ.

Joe was a sharp dresser with a very humorous personality. He loved his entire family. Growing up, Joe, Linda, Dale and Rocky were always together. Joe was always right, never wrong. As far as his mother and grandmother were concerned, Joe could do no wrong. Although Joe and Rocky were first cousins, their close relationship made them brothers. Joe was like another son to his Uncle Manning.

Joe loved football, boxing, basketball, shooting pool, music and trying to sing. He especially loved Frankie Beverly and Maze, as well as the Chicago Bears and the American Legion.
