Pastor Theodore Godfrey McNair was born Wednesday, August 9, 1967, in Fayetteville, NC, son of the late Theodore McNair and the late Dorothy Lee McNair.

A graduate of John Harris High School, Class of 1985, Harrisburg, PA, he attended Cheyney University where he majored in Architectural Design. An entrepreneur of many trades, his career included ownership of two Daycare Centers, McNair’s Daycare and Big Hearts Little Hands Daycare. Most recently, he was employed by 20 20 Auto Sales under Mr. Eddie Ruth. He pastored Inspirational Temple Church of Harrisburg.
