Thomas E. Williams Jr., son of the late Thomas E. Williams Sr. and the late Bertha M. Brown Williams, was born Wednesday, June 24, 1942, in Harrisburg, PA.

A graduate of John Harris High School, Class of 1960, he pursued higher education at Harrisburg Area Community College where he earned an Associate's Degree in Business Administration in 1965. For five years, he served honorably in the U.S. Army and was the recipient of the Good Conduct Medal. This dedicated, hardworking man of integrity was employed by and retired from the Commonwealth of PA, Division of Photogrammetry. He served as President of AFSCME Council 13, Region 5, for seven years.

His passionate nature was evident in his athletic abilities and in his personal life. He was a Harrisburg Packer Weighmaster, Highspire Tee-Ball Coach, spirited Philadelphia Eagles Fan, and an active member of Gold's Gym Silver Sneakers Program. However, most importantly, he never missed an athletic event during his son's twenty-year athletic career. A phenomenal chef, Thomas was also an avid deep-sea fisherman as well as a carpenter, "do-it-all, fix-it," and he loved to travel. His faith was evidenced by his Christian fellowship with the former Mount Lebanon Primitive Baptist Church presently Turner Memorial Missionary Baptist Church.

At seventy-four years of age, in Harrisburg, on Friday, September 2, 2016, Thomas departed this life joining in eternal life his parents, four sisters, Vivian O. Shelley, Winnie L. Williams Anthony, Victoria Williams, Helen M. Williams and other loved ones.
