Tiffany Nadine Street-Beka, daughter of Herbert Nelson Street Sr. and Helen Rebecca Pierce-Street, was born October 31, 1970, in Bridgeton, New Jersey. Tiffany graduated from Messiah College, Mechanicsburg, PA, where she was the recipient of the Multicultural and International Impact Award. Tiffany received her Master Herbalist Degree from Trinity School of Natural Health. She was a missionary to Merida, Mexico; worshipper with Harrisburg Justice House of Prayer, Harrisburg, PA; ordained minister with Ezekiel's Trumpets, Harrisburg, PA; co-founder of In His Service Ministry; starter of her own small business, Tiffany Nadine Creations; singer, intercessor, worshipper, minister, teacher in many ministries and churches, Ezekiel's Trumpets, March for Jesus, Shining His Light Ministries, Shalom House, Saint Paul's Missionary Baptist Church and Kingdom Embassy, to name a few.

Tiffany was known and loved by many names: Aunt Tiffany, Mamma Tiffany, Mamma T, Sister Tiffany, Morah and Nataepu Sipu Atehumwit (her native American name meaning-- Stands at the River Singing). She was kind to all she encountered and an inspiration, counselor and confidant to many.

On Tuesday, April 14, 2020, at forty-nine years of age, Tiffany transitioned while at her home in Carlisle, PA. Along with her mother and father, she is survived by her husband, Sava Beka; younger brother, Herbert Nelson Street Jr.; sister-in-law, Christine Street; beloved Ward Justin Matthew Schell; four

godchildren, aunts, uncles, cousins, nephews, nieces, great-nephews, great-nieces, many spiritual children and a multitude of beloved friends.

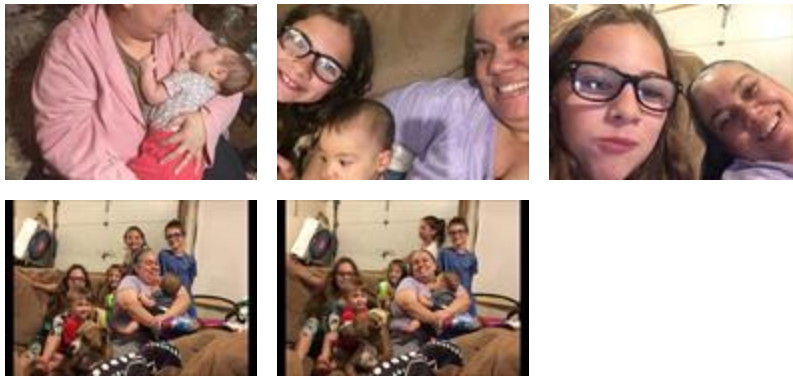
