Tracy S. Wilson, son of Matthew Shorter Sr. and the late Lenora D. Wilson, was born Wednesday, July 24, 1974, in Cocoa, Florida.

Tracy graduated from high school in Cocoa, FL. During his high school years, he played in the band, and as an all-around athlete, he played basketball and earned the distinction of being one of the fastest track runners in the State of Florida. Tracy completed two years of college in Fort Hood, TX, and served his country honorably in the United States Army. Tracy's employment path included five years with the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA), fifteen years with AXA Network (Crump) and, lastly, three years with PerformCare, all in Harrisburg, PA.

An avid sports fan of Florida State and the Dallas Cowboys, Tracy also had a keen interest and enthusiasm for barbecuing. He was a member of the Kansas City BBQ Society (KCBS) as well as a PA Certified BBQ Judge. He loved cooking for his family and friends.

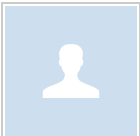
