Waymond Steele Sr., 91, of Harrisburg, transitioned into eternal life on Friday, February 22, 2013, while at the Jewish Home of Greater Harrisburg. He was born September 6, 1921 in Columbia, SC, son of the late Dolph and Mattie (White) Steele, and was educated in the Reeder Point public school system of SC.

A WWII Army Veteran, he was a loyal employee of the former Bethlehem Steel Corp., Steelton, retiring after 41 years of service. He was a member of the Camp Curtin Memorial Mitchell United Methodist Church and served as a volunteer in the church's soup kitchen. He was a former member of Elks Cyrene Lodge #169, Steelton; the American Legion Ephraim Slaughter Post #733 and the Auxiliary Police Force. Leisurely, he enjoyed watching old western movies, gardening and playing cards.

Mr. Steele was preceded in death by his wife of 48 years, Sarah (Epps) Steele; daughter, Viola Stroble; grandchildren, Kendrick Steele, Laronda and Keith Stroble; and brother, Julius Steele.
