



## Reverend Willie Phillips

June 19, 1927 - December 30, 2020

Reverend Willie Phillips, son of the late Lee Phillips and Carrie Wallace Phillips, was born Sunday, June 19, 1927, in Rock Hill, South Carolina.

Reverend Phillips received a diploma in the field of Horticulture and had a special interest in the study of tree farming. A World War II United States Army Veteran, he was awarded the EAME Service Medal with two Bronze Service Stars, the Good Conduct and World War II Victory Medal. His employment path included Harrisburg Police Department and retirement from Benardi Brothers. He was a member of Harris AME Zion Church and affiliated with New Anointed Christian Fellowship Ministries serving with the Ministerial Staff and as Assistant Minister. Reverend Phillips was also a former member of the Fraternal Order of Police as well as a Cub and Boy Scout Leader.

At the blessed age of ninety-three while at the Middletown Home, Middletown, PA, on Wednesday, December 30, 2020, Reverend Willie Phillips transitioned from labor to reward joining in eternal life his parents, his wife, Edna A. Ruth Phillips, and his siblings.
